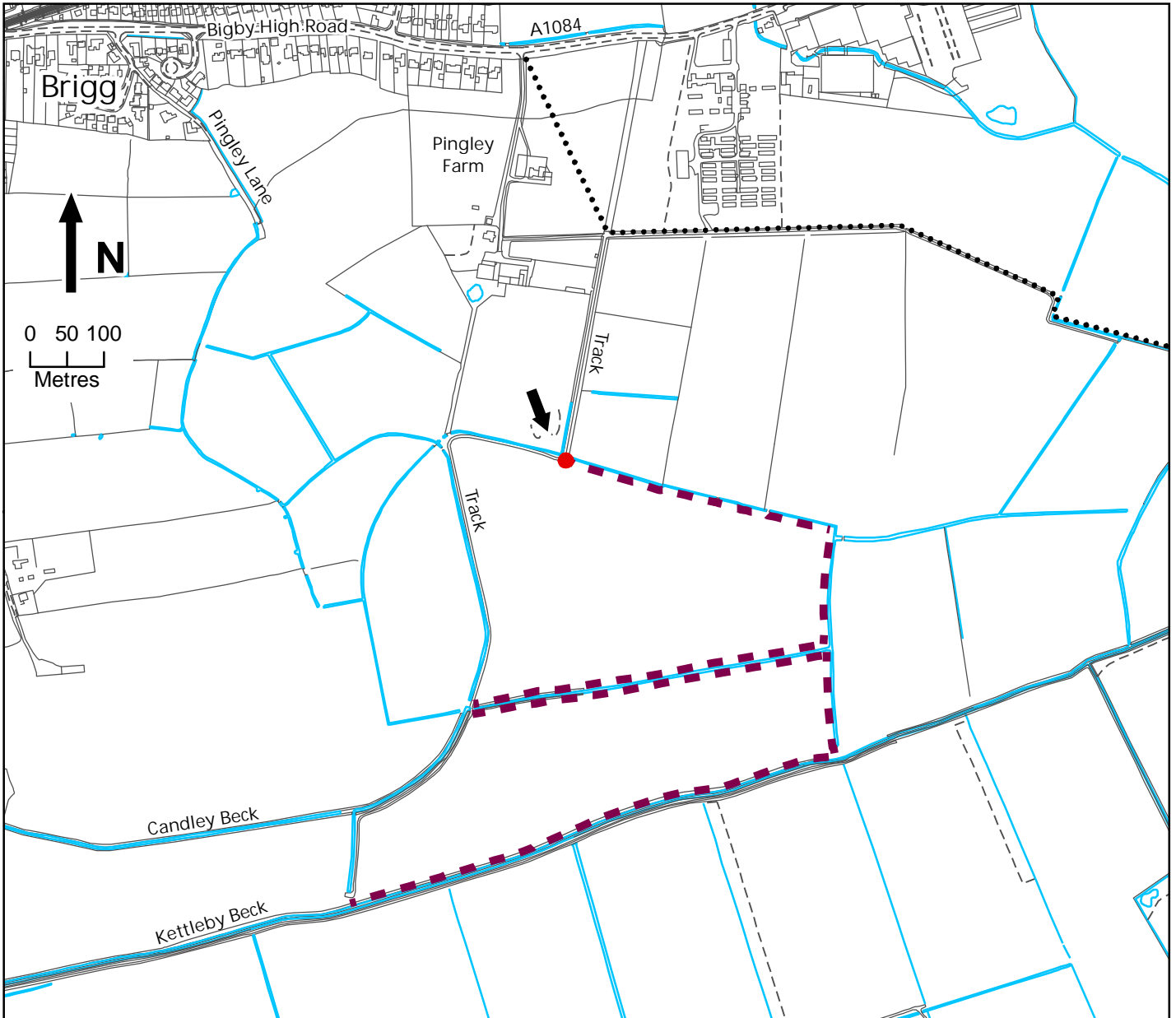


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

This permissive bridleway runs through Manor farm and has been established as part of their Natural England Environmental Stewardship (ES) Scheme. It is open for quiet enjoyment by horse riders, pedestrians and cyclists. You may be able to see some of the measures introduced within the immediate arable fields for the benefit of endangered species e.g. over-wintered stubbles, spring cereals, summer fallows, grass margins. Elsewhere across the farm, hedgerows and pockets of grassland and wet woodland are being sympathetically managed to retain their landscape and habitat interest. Please respect the habitat value of the grassland margins running parallel to this bridleway and restrict your use to the access track. Thank you.
