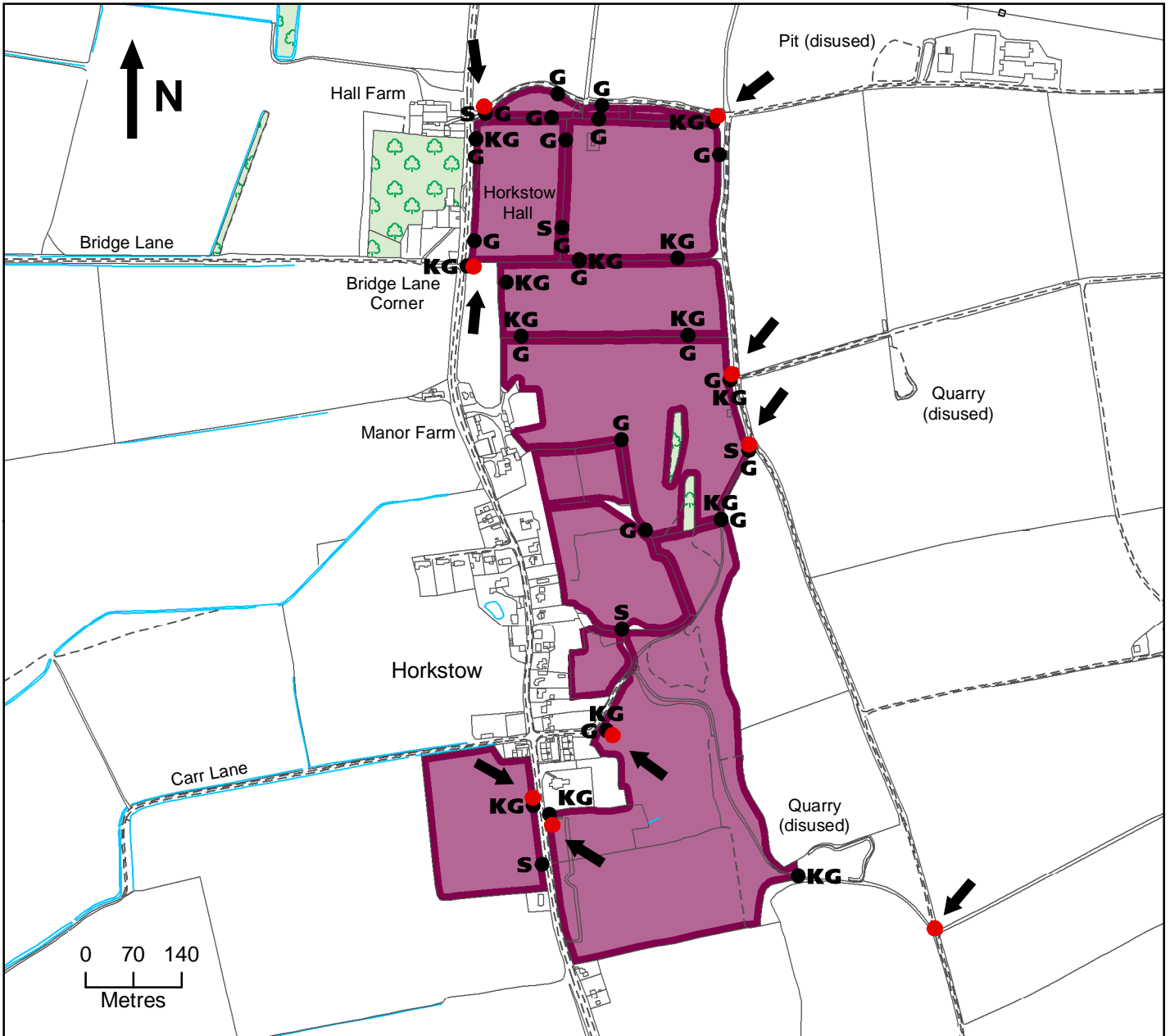


PERMISSIVE ACCESS

This permissive open access has been created on these archaeologically rich, grazed pastures for the quiet enjoyment of the countryside with excellent views provided over the Ancholme Valley. Look out for owls, buzzards and deer along with other smaller bird and mammal species. This access has been provided through the 'Higher Level Stewardship Scheme' and 'LFC Horkstow Ltd' for a period of 10 years. The rest of the farm is also being managed for wildlife and historic features. PLEASE SHUT ANY FIELD GATES AFTER YOU AND KEEP DOGS ON A LEAD. WE HOPE YOU ENJOY YOUR WALK.
